SANQUHAR HISTORIC WALK

Circular town and outskirts walk

PARKING From Dumfries follow the A76 Glasgow Road to Sanquhar. Continue along the High Street and turn left in front of the Tolbooth Museum to reach the public car park. There are toilets further along this street.

- **START** Before setting out on this historic trail you may like to visit Sanquhar Museum in the Tolbooth where you will find well presented local history to enhance the experience of your walk.
- Pick up the leaflet 'Sanquhar The Historic Walk' from various shops in the High Street for information on places of interest along the walk.

Continue along the High Street. At St Ninian's Baptist Church the High Street joins Castle Street. Pass the bus shelter after the last house on the right hand side of Castle Street and turn right through the kissing gate into the avenue of ash trees leading towards Sanquhar Castle. Follow the 'easy route' signs through the gap in the wall and continue alongside the railings passing through two more kissing gates. Continue around the perimeter of the housing estate and the playing green. On reaching the Deer Dyke turn right and follow the path and wall towards the tower of the Tolbooth. This takes you to the left side of the primary school and back to the car park.
