ST MUNGO'S TO GLENHOLM

- Circular riverside and quiet road walk
- 3km/2 miles
- I hour
- Hard surfaced tracks and road
- Moderate
- Stout shoes or boots recommended

PARKING From Lochmaben take the B7020 Dalton Road past Hightae and take the first left in the woodland signed Lockerbie 5 miles. Cross the River Annan and take the first right sign-posted Cemetery. On reaching the churchyard park without obstructing access to the gates.

start Turn left along the road and then first right. Pass the entrance to Bowmillholm and on through the S bends. Descend the long straight until you reach a strip of woodland on the right that runs away from the road. Turn right down the road bordering the wood and on reaching the crossroads continue straight ahead. Follow this track to the far edge of the replanted woodland and turn left in front of the gate to the field.

Follow the beech trees on your right to join a fine beech lined track between the fields. Continue until you meet the minor road and turn left. The river across the field to your right is the Water of Milk.

On reaching the junction, cross the road and follow the estate track past the lodge into the woodland. Continue past the ruins of Milkbank House. At the T-junction with the public road, turn left and head uphill. Views include Kettleholm Kirk, the towers of Castlemilk House (through the trees) and Burnswark Hill on the skyline.

Continue uphill to the crossroads and turn left. This road skirts Nutholm Hill, and gives uninterrupted views across Annandale, before descending to St Mungo's and the start.
